Outcome/added value for target group	<p>Joining students from different backgrounds broaden their social skills, cognitive skills and expand their view on society and their role in that society. During the Talent School, students experience all sorts of tasks and challenges and get to meet young people from other schools and backgrounds, which connects them more to local society. Especially for students that are newcomers in Dutch Society (the joining ISK-students), the Talent Schools proves to be very valuable. These students in particular were very enthusiastic about the variety of workshops. By doing the workshops they expanded their understanding and scope of Dutch education/society and their possibilities in the Netherlands.</p> <p>Participants (n=27 and n=40) said they learned multiple new things, such as: cooperation with people you don't know that well; how to present yourself; discovered new musical/creative talents, etc. They gained confidence, made new friends, learned how to cook a meal for 50 people, tried new sports and creative skills and many more things, depending on the workshops they attended.</p>
Content in detail	<p>The consequences of the Covid-19 lockdown and mainly online school-lessons, caused learning deficiencies for some high school students in the age 12-18. This appeared to be especially the case for students with already disadvantaged backgrounds. The Talent School was developed to organise something fun to encourage talent development for students that missed out on school and the benefits of social school life outside their home.</p> <p>The Bossche Talentschool is a holiday-week-program (organised by first and second year higher vocational students Social Work under guidance of social work and education professionals) in which students/pupils from all secondary education schools are invited to execute and expand their skills and talents. Through a broad workshop program in small Covidproof groups of max 9 students (<i>20 sessions per day, divided over 4 timeslots, so 100 in total, of which around 45 unique workshops</i>) students get inspired and challenged.</p> <p>The programme is a diverse mix of creative, musical and athletic workshops combined with cognitive challenges focused on personal development. Students meet new people, get to experiment with new content and tasks and have fun all at the same time. To stimulate social interaction between the students, there is a shared opening and closing of the Talent School with all participants. The Bossche Talent School reaches out to a diverse group of students: from the newcomers, to students with special needs and students that were connected by youth workers in the city.</p>

The workshops are organised in The Bossche Vakschool, but are extra-curricular and focused on non-formal methods of education. The first edition was carried out in the national Summer holiday of 2020, the second edition in the spring holiday in February 2021. The method of the Talent School was born during the Covid-19 pandemic and is being further developed with each edition.</p> <p>A broad team of professionals from local Foundation Ondernemend Onderwijs 'sH (Entrepreneurial Education), youth workers from PowerUP073, students Social Work from Avans School for higher professional education and team members of secondary school Bossche Vakschool, organised this week together with the workshop leaders. Workshops are given voluntarily by professional trainers/ teachers with various specialisms, as well as students from higher professional education Social Work.</p> <p>Funding for pocket money expenses and small thank-you gift cards for the workshop leaders was provided by CityBoost 'sH, a program of the municipality of 's-Hertogenbosch to encourage young people organise events or projects for their local environment.</p>
